



Keep your ICE Card in your car and wallet.

In addition to carrying ICE Identification Cards, you can program your ICE contact information into your cell phone.

To program ICE into your cell phone:

- Access the address book feature of your cell phone.
- Enter the word ICE.
- Enter the phone number of your spouse, parent or anyone who should be contacted in the event of an emergency.



Complete one set of ICE Cards for your vehicle's glove box or center console, and another set for your wallet or purse.
